

**ORDINANCE NO. LC-3294**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LANDMARKS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS; REPEALING EXISTING OVERLAND PARK MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.17.**

WHEREAS, the City created the Landmarks Commission in 1985 to oversee and preserve historical properties within the City of Overland Park; and

WHEREAS, the Kansas State Historic Preservation Office operates and administers a state-wide program working with issues related to historic buildings and structures, associated programs and tax incentives, and archeological resources of Kansas; it further provides help to property owners regarding preservation programs, grants, tax credits, technical assistance and certification; and it administers both the State and National Register of Historic Places in Kansas; and

WHEREAS, in light of the minimal use of the City’s Landmarks Commission and the availability of the State Historic Preservation Office’s program discussed above, the Governing Body has determined there is no longer a need for the City’s Landmark Commission, and accordingly it is therefore appropriate to discontinue said commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Existing Overland Park Municipal Code Chapter 2.17, consisting of Sections 2.17.010 through 2.17.110, is hereby repealed.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force as of the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
