

ORDINANCE NO. ZRR-3300
SUMMARY

On December 7, 2020, the City of Overland Park, Kansas adopted Ordinance No. ZRR-3300, entitled, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS RELATING TO THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE AND THE REGULATION OF SIGNS; AMENDING AND REPEALING EXISTING OVERLAND PARK MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 18.100.041, 18.110.440, 18.110.625, 18.250.050, 18.370.020, 18.370.040, 18.390.140, 18.440.010, 18.440.020, 18.440.030, 18.440.040, 18.440.050, 18.440.060, 18.440.070, 18.440.080, 18.440.090, 18.440.100, 18.440.110, 18.440.120, 18.440.130 AND 18.440.140 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREFOR; ADDING NEW SECTIONS 18.110.175, 18.110.492, 18.440.000, 18.440.150, 18.440.160, 18.440.170, 18.440.180, 18.440.190 AND 18.440.200; AND REPEALING CHAPTER 18.442 AND SECTIONS 18.110.560, 18.110.565, 18.110.570, 18.110.575, 18.110.580, 18.130.060, 18.130.070, 18.410.100, 18.440.055 AND 18.440.085.

The Ordinance updates and restates the provisions of Chapter 18.440 of the Overland Park Municipal Code, which establishes the City’s zoning regulations in the Unified Development Code regarding signs (sometimes referred to as the City’s “Sign Code”). It further consolidates several other provisions throughout the Unified Development Ordinance regarding signs into the Sign Code, and revises the remaining provisions regarding or referencing signs in order to make them consistent with the Sign Code. (These other provisions are identified above.)
