

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS**

The City of Overland Park, Kansas (the “City”), will conduct a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as is practical) on Monday, June 21, 2021, in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 8500 Santa Fe Drive, Overland Park, Kansas, to consider substantial changes to a STAR bond project plan (the “Revised STAR Bond Project Plan”) for the STAR bond project area within a STAR bond project district, which district is commonly referred to as the Bluhawk STAR Bond Project District and which is located in the general vicinity of the southwest corner of 159<sup>th</sup> Street and U.S. Highway 69 in the City, in accordance with K.S.A. 12-17,160 to 12-17,179, inclusive, as amended.

The meeting and the hearing will be open to the public. Interested members of the public are invited to attend the hearing and will have an opportunity to express their views with respect to the Revised STAR Bond Project Plan.

A copy of the Revised STAR Bond Project Plan, including a summary of the feasibility study, the market study, the relocation assistance plan, any financial guarantees of the prospective developer, and a description and map of the area to be redeveloped to be considered by the City on June 21, 2021, are on file in the office of the City Clerk and are available for public inspection during normal business hours.
